

Damage Caused by Crows is Increasing at Garbage Collection Sites

Crows often scatter garbage out of bags at collection sites. To prevent such trouble, follow the next points. ① Cover garbage bags tightly with protection net. ②Be sure to take out garbage bags at collection site by 8:30 on the day, not on the previous day or during the night. ③Crows look for food with their eyes. NOTICE! Be Careful Not to Get Heat Stroke (熱中症 ねっちゅうしょう Necchu-sho) Especially When Wearing a Mask!

Hot and humid weather is one of important factors which cause Heat Stroke. And wearing a mask increases the risk of the stroke. It is important to take care not only for the prevention of infection diseases, but also for not getting heat strokes.




5 points of Heat Stroke Prevention When Wearing a Mask ····

1. Take water frequently. Remind to intake salt when you sweat a lot.



2. Wear cool cloths and use cooler and fans to eliminate heat from body





4. Check your health condition and do not overdo when not good. Remember to have a breakfast and hydration.



5. When enough social distancing (2m or over) is secured at outdoor, take off your mask to remove heat. When wearing mask, avoid hard exercise or work.
