

### Cashless Payment Point Return Project

To promote cashless payment required in the new way of living, expand cashless payment among small and medium-sized shops and stimulate consumption, the City will carry out cashless payment point return project. # Life Support Special Benefit to Child-Rearing Households

To support child-rearing households affected by Covid-19, the City will provide special benefits. Application is required.

#### Targeted Households

Shingle parent household: ①Those who received child-rearing allowance for April, 2021 \*Special benefit was already provided. ②Those who can't receive child-rearing allowance because of being recipient of public pension ③Those who have gotten qualification to receive child-rearing allowance because of being affected by Covid-19.

•Child-rearing households except for single parent: ①Those who have received child-rearing allowance or special child-rearing allowance and are exempted from inhabitant tax for the 2021 fiscal year. \*Application is not required.

<sup>(2)</sup>Parents or guardians who were rearing children under 18 (children with disability under 20) as of Mar. 31,2021 and are exempted from inhabitant tax for the 2021 fiscal year or whose income has been at the level of being exempted from inhabitant tax because they have been affected by Covid-19 since Jan.1, 2021.




