#### Notify National Health Insurance Card when children move out of the city for studies.

When children of household who got National health insurance leave their parents and move out of the city for studies, please notify as the existing National health insurance card can be used.

What you need for notification: National health insurance card, certificate of enrollment (student ID), documents which show individual number of the head of household and child, and ID document of a notifier (person who made the notification.)

Place of notification: Kokuho nenkin-ka (National health insurance and National pension section), branch offices, Civic centers. **Note:** when children graduated from school and got social insurance, please notify quickly. **Contact:** Kokuho nenkin-ka, Inazawa city Tel 0587-32-1312

#### NOTICE FROM POLICE STATION Don't Text and Drive!

It is extremely danger and illegal to talk on the phone or watch a display screen of the phone while walking, driving a car or riding a bicycle. The offender is imposed **a fine of 18,000 yen** (standard-sized car) and a penalty of 3 points. When a driver caused a traffic accident, the penalty is up to one year in prison or a fine of up to 300,000 yen. Furthermore, walking while using a phone causes a risk of crash between cars and pedestrian. Adults should be a role model for children. Let's follow the traffic rules so as not to cause traffic accidents.

●Who needs to declare: People who are residents of Inazawa City as of Jan. 1, 2023 and their condition in 2022 meet any of the following ① - ④

①Those who are not obliged to declare final tax return but want to take deduction of residential taxes. ② Salaried workers whose salary payment report is not submitted to the City from their workplace. ③Salaried workers who received income of 200,000 yen or less excluding incomes from salary and retirement allowance ④Those who should declare for another reason but ① - ③

# To Comers to Consultation for *Kakuteishinkoku* (Final Tax Return) & *Shi* & *Kenminzei no*Shinkoku (Declaration of Municipal & Prefectural Taxes)

Please observe the following.

1) Measure temperature at entrance

Those who have fever of 37.5  $\,^\circ\!\mathrm{C}\,$  or above, symptom of cold, or who refuses to measure temperature cannot be admitted to enter.

2) Always keep wearing mask Sterilize hands and fingers at entrance

3) Visit in a small number of people

Only the person to declare or consult should be admitted.

Even if the person needs people for assistance, the number of attendants should be minimum.


## To Those who join 'Momiai (Jostling)',

Be Careful of PM 2.5 Contact: Kankyo Hozen-ka in Kankyo Center Tel. 0587-36-3710 From winter to spring, the density of PM 2.5 is possible to rise. In case the average density of the day is expected to be over 70 microgram / m³, Aichi prefecture will issue a warning. When the warning is issued, try to follow the next points.

- ·Reduce going out for unessential matters. Wear a mask when going out.
- Reduce long-term heavy outdoor exercises.

As for people who have respiratory or circulatory diseases, younger children or the aged, take those points more seriously according to their health condition. The City is providing PM 2.5 related information offered by Aichi Prefecture through 'Kinkvujoho-haishin mail (emergency information distributing mail)'.
