Fire Prevention Campaign in Spring March 1 – $7\sim$ 10 Points to Protect Your Life \sim

56 fires broke out in 2021. 17 fires among them are suspected of arson. To prevent arsons, never leave anything flammable around houses.

Four Habits

- Never smoke in bed.
- Never use stoves near the flammable items.
- 3 Turn off space heaters such as a gas cooker when you are away.
- 4 Clean off dusts around outlets and take off the plugs when not used.

Six Measures

- 1) Use stoves and heater with a safety device
- ② Establish a home fire-alarm and exchenge every 10 years.
- ③ Keep rooms organized and use the fire-proofed Bedding, cloths and curtains.
- 4 Establish a home fire-extinguisher.
- ⑤ Set up a good neighbors' cooperative support system to protect the elderly and the physically disabled people.
- 6 Participate in fire and disaster prevention drills.

Expanding of the Target of "Inazawa Odekake Taxi" from Apr. 1 (Fri)

To Those with Above Certain Earnings The Burden Ratio of Medical Costs for Elderly People is altered.

From October 1 (Sat), the burden ration (copayment) of medical costs for elderly people earning income at the same levels as active workers is altered from 10 % to 20% excluding those with income comparable to current force (30% copayment). This alteration applies to approx. 20% of the total number of elderly people insured. Your burden ratio (copayment) will be shown in the new health insurance card which will be sent around September.

When you make application for programs, make sure to include the following items in your information. The Common Items for Application: ①the title of the program, ②the applicant's name with kana pronouncing, ③his/her address, postcode and phone number, and ④other information to be written.

<u>Using a Smartphone for the Payment of City Tax and Charges</u> makes you more Convenient.

From April, FamiPay and au PAY are added to the following **target applications** for payment of city tax and chares using a smartphone. Furthermore, **from July**, these applications can be used for payment of an insurance premium of medical care for seniors. Please use it.

Target Applications: LINEPay, PayPay, PayB. From April: FamiPay, au PAY

Target Items: city tax & prefectural residence tax, fixed asset tax, city planning tax, light motor vehicle tax (), national health insurance tax, premium for nursing-care insurance,

day-care fee, overtime day-care fee (public nursery school), nursery school lunch (public nursery school), fee for after school, municipal housing rent, municipal housing parking fee, Sobue cemetery operation and management fee. **From July**: insurance premium for seniors (direct payment by individual taxpayer) **Recommendation of Registration of Account Transfer:** Once registered, the payment is made through automatic withdrawal on the payment deadline. You will not care of deadline anymore.

Application: apply for registration of account transfer at financial institutions designated by the city, or city hall tax payment division (shuno-ka) or service counter at city branch offices or civic centers with a pass book and a seal used to open and associated with a bank account. Account Transfer starts for the payment due on the end of next month after receipt of bank transfer request form.

If you wish to pay the fixed asset tax, city planning tax (1st term, prepayment) through account transfer, you need to complete the application process by March 31 (Thu).

The following methods for payment of city tax and charges are available in addition to the payment by smartphone and account transfer.

- ①City hall, city branch office, civic center, financial institutions designated by the city
- ②Convenience stores
- ③Credit cards, Pay-easy (Inazawa city payment site)*
- ④eLTAX (common tax payment system)*

Noticing · Calling · Listening:

Let's notice the troubles of the people around you, call out and listen.

"Different from usual" is keys to notice, for example, 'cannot sleep', 'no appetite', 'speak fewer words'.

If you notice the situation, try calling out and listen to the story slowly over time.

Bridaina:

Let's encourage the person to consult with the experts as soon as possible when you notice "something different Also ask cooperation to his /her families or friends who understand well the from usual" about him/her. circumstances and feelings in which they are located, and work as a bridge to consultation with experts.

Watch over:

Let's watch over slowly while staring warmly

Telling that "You are an important being" gives the power to live on.

Let's talk to with a natural atmosphere and keep watching gently and closely.

Also, let's take care to reduce the burden on him/her body and mind at home and at work.
