RESIDENT TAX-EXEMPT HOUSEHOLD ONE-TIME SPECIAL BENEFITS

In a severe and protracted economic situation affected by **COVID-19**, the cash benefit of 100,000 yen per one household is provided to the resident tax-exempt households to support their daily life.

Target and Application

- ① As of the base date (December 10, 2021), those who have registered as a resident at City Hall and all members of the household are resident-tax exempt. A confirmation form will be sent in early February. Please fill in and return.
- ② Households who are granted as the case of ① due to the deterioration of the family finance affected by COVID-19. Acceptance of application starts from February 7 (Mon) at Kyufukin Madoguchi (benefits counter) in City Hall east building, conference room 12. (acceptable application by mail)

COVID-19: APPLICATION for SELF-SUPPORT FUND for NEEDY PERSON is EXTENDED by the END-MARCH.

Target

Households who have finished making a loan of comprehensive support funds by Social Welfare Council or were not allowed to make a further loan or were not allowed to apply in despite of consultation about making a further loan but meet requirements for income, assets and job hunting (except households receiving welfare aid).

FUND

Single person household: 60,000 yen Household of two: 80,000 yen

Household of three or more: 100,000 yen

3 months after application

To Comers to Consultation for *Kakuteishinkoku* (Final Tax Return) & Shi & Kenminzei no Shinkoku (Declaration of Municipal & Prefectural Taxes) Please observe the following.

1) Measure temperature at entrance

Those who have fever of 37.5 $^{\circ}$ C or above, symptom of cold, or who refuses to measure temperature cannot be admitted to enter.

- 2) Always keep wearing mask Sterilize hands and fingers at entrance
- 3) Visit in a small number of people

Only the person to declare or consult should be admitted.

Even if the person needs people for assistance, the number of attendants should be minimum.

When you make application for programs, make sure to include the following items in your information.

The Common Items for Application: ①the title of the program, ②the applicant's name with kana pronouncing. ③his/her address, postcode and phone number, and ④other information to be written.



Be Careful of PM 2.5 Inquiry: Kankyo Hozenka in kankyo Center Tel. 0587-36-3710

From winter to spring, the density of PM 2.5 is possible to rise. In case the average density of the day is expected to be over 70 microgram / m³, Aichi prefecture will issue a warning. When the warning is issued, try to follow the next points.

- Reduce going out for unessential matters and wear a mask when going out.
- Reduce long-term heavy outdoor exercises.



As for people who have respiratory or circulatory diseases, younger children or the aged, take those points more seriously according to their health condition. The City is providing PM 2.5 related information offered by Aichi Prefecture through 'kinkyujoho-haishin mail (emergency information distributing mail)'.

Children are easy to get sick. But there is the disease preventing by vaccination. Please confirm your maternity book whether you do not forget to be vaccinated.
